Map Cuts:

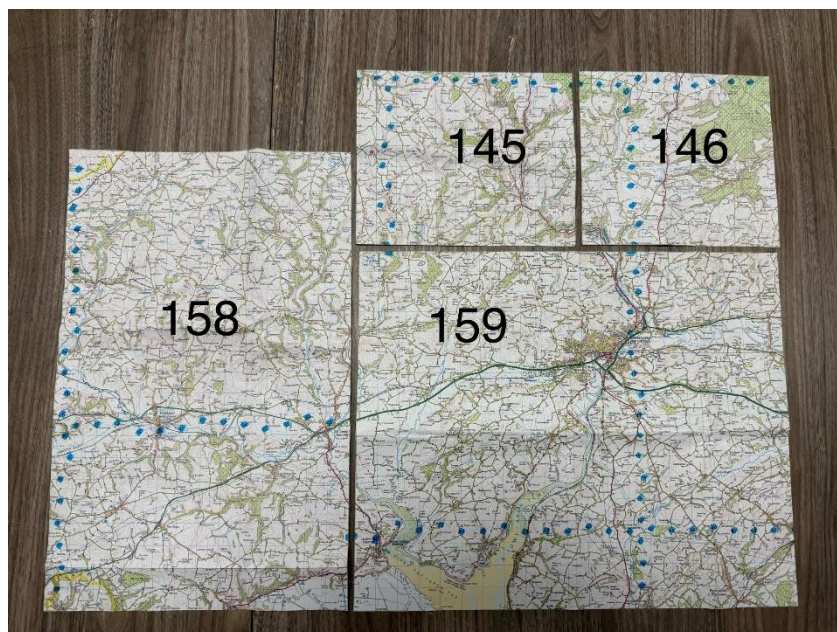
You will need the following map squares;

159: North of line 08
West of line 50

158: North of line 08
East of line 15

146: West of line 50
South of line 34

145: South of line 34
East of line 29
North of line 25



***Please cut the maps out as detailed above, stick them together, and present it at signing on for inspection*.**

Outline Schedule:

Saturday 12th September 2026

Marshal Signing on:

- Marshal Signing on will open at **16:00pm** and close at **20:30pm sharp!** Can crews remind their marshals of the earlier than usual closing time, please.
- The closing time will be strictly enforced as per **R.8 NO MARSHAL - NO START - NO REFUND – NO DISCUSSION**

Competitor Signing on:

- Noise and Scrutineering will be between 16:00pm and 20:30pm
- Competitor signing on to close at 21:00pm
- Driver/Navigator Briefing to be held in the signing on area at 21:30pm; Mandatory for all crews please.

Regulations Amendments:

12. Scrutineering

Tyres

Reminder: **“Only E marked tyres will be permitted to be used”**

13. Controls

Delete: Route checks will be preceded by a “C” or Control board at approximately 2 foot ahead of the board.

Add: For Route checks, a ‘C’ board will be placed on the plot and the Route Check board 1metre behind it at a right angle to the direction of travel.

For Route Checks which may be used to replace a PC, then the ‘C’ board will be placed 50metres prior, with the Route Check placed on the plot - facing the competitor.

Further Information:

- Route information will be issued at MC0; To allow more plotting time, the first novice crew will receive their route information 30 minutes before their due time at MC0. The first Semi-Expert crew will receive their route information 15 minutes before their due time
The official notice board will have a list of start times at MC0 and MC1 for all crews
- D.O.E authorisation will be available for inspection at signing on
- The Basic Roamer Company will be attending the start venue
- Please ensure that you have written in your competition number on all event documentation
- Total mileage will be approximately 100 miles. Fuel will be available after approximately 45 miles
- All competitors are required to wear seatbelts/harnesses at all times.
- A warning that any competitor found to be unnecessarily dropping time on neutral sections may be disqualified.
- Breakfast tickets will be handed out at MC4, at the finish venue.
- Please ensure that your competition licence is Interclub status or higher. Clubman licences are NOT VALID on this event. Please contact the Entries Secretary (Ryland James 07773 346878) if you have any queries.

Fuel

Fuel is available 24 hours a day at the Tenby Road Filling Station (159: 367 193). This is on the eastbound carriageway of the A40, approximately 1 mile west of the start venue. To access the fuel station from the start venue, continue past on the west bound carriageway until you reach a suitable crossing point.

The halfway fuel halt **DOES** sell E5 Super Unleaded

Noise/Scrutineering

Will be held on the grounds of Coleg Sir Gar, Pibwrlwyd Campus (159: 41 3 18 2.25), as shown in the plan below. Please follow arrows and Marshals instructions.

Note: No cars are to be unloaded from trailers within this area.

Particular attention will be paid at pre-event scrutineering, and during the event, to Tyres. Competitors are to ensure compliance with Event Regulation 12, Motorsport UK Regulations, and the Road Traffic Act at all times. Non-compliance will result in non-start or exclusion from the event, as appropriate.

Trailer Park

Will be at the Carmarthen Livestock Mart, Llanllwch. (159: 37 9 18 9.75)

Please follow Marshals instructions and park as allocated.

Note: Trailers are left at your own risk.

Start Car Park/ Signing On

Will be at Carmarthen Livestock Mart, Llanllwch. (159: 37 9 18 9.75)

Park as shown in the plan below and as instructed by Marshals.

Seeding

No discussion will be had regarding seeding and a penalty, at the discretion of the Clerks of the Course, may be applied for any breaches.

Route Plotting

NOTE: DUE TO SPECTATOR RELATED PR PROBLEMS, ANY COMPETITOR FOUND TO BE DIVULGING ROUTE INFORMATION TO NON-COMPETITORS MAY BE EXCLUDED.

Marshal's equipment

All marshals should equip themselves appropriately, to include the following;

- OS maps 145, 146, 158 & 159 (1:50.000 OS Landranger Series) latest editions
- Their own Hi-Viz vests
- Ensuring they have access to the 'What 3 Words' app before arriving at the start.
- A suitable hammer to place their Control Board

PLEASE NOTE:

PR work before the event has identified some locations where local residents have requested disturbance to be minimised. Competitors **MUST** heed quiet zones along the route. There is no reason or excuse not to pay attention to these requirements; any crew not complying with these requirements will be **DISQUALIFIED**. DSO's will be present at these locations.

We hope you have an enjoyable rally and we look forward to seeing you all on Saturday afternoon at the Carmarthen Cattle Market. We wish you a safe journey to and from the event.
