FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry and we hope that you have an enjoyable day's sport. Your competition nr is indicated on the attached entry list.

5 nr personnel entrance passes will be attached to your mailed out copy of these Final Instructions. **These will be required by Driver, Co-driver and up to three associated personnel.** Under current Covid regulations, you may bring more than three personnel, but any additional members will be required to pay the normal spectator entrance charge. If the Covid regulations change to restrict numbers at the venue prior to the event, then it is possible that no additional personnel can be admitted.

Please ensure that you make your own arrangements to distribute passes within your team. If numbers become restricted under revised Covid regulations, then no admission without a pass can be permitted (including drivers or co-drivers).

Your <u>provisional</u> start time is 09.00 plus half your car number (rounded up). (For example, car nr 31 will start at 09.00+16 = 09.16). Actual due times at MC1 will be indicated on your time-card nr 1 issued with your documentation.

Access to the service area will be the same as for recent events. After passing through the personnel pass check at the main gate, **competitors** with Competitor personnel passes should bear right in front of the Medical Centre (via the main crossroads) to cross the circuit at the Formula One Bar. This will be arrowed for those unfamiliar with the venue.

Most of the normal pre-event procedures will have been carried out online self-certification prior to the event. On the day, unload in the paddock area and follow arrows to the noise test (located near the control tower) where you will receive your process card. On successful completion of the noise test, proceed to limited scrutineering (Cut-outs and seats) within or adjacent to the scrutineering bays, depending on weather. One person only to be with the car at scrutineering and facemasks shall be worn by all drivers. On successful completion, exchange your process card for your documentation at the Rally office (opposite scrutineering bays). Noise, scrutineering and documentation

open at 6.00am and will close at 08.15am. No vehicles will be admitted into the paddock area after 8.15am.

In the interests of safety, please observe a one-way system around the main Service Area by travelling in an **anti-clockwise direction** on this occasion.

Rally Marketing will be selling competition numbers etc at Pembrey on Tuesday morning.

Please note the following amendments to the regulations:

Your particular attention is drawn to the Motorsport UK's published requirements for Health & Safety in Service Areas. Please ensure that you familiarise yourselves with these requirements **prior to the event**. Particular attention is drawn to regulation 24 - Refuelling:

24. REFUELLING All competitors shall familiarise themselves with the recommendations published by Motorsport UK with regard to the refuelling of competing vehicles on the event. A refuelling zone has been set up near to the service area for this purpose and it is mandatory that competitors make use of this facility. BOTH CREW MEMBERS MUST BE OUT OF THE CAR WHILST REFUELLING TAKES PLACE. NO REFUELLING TO BE CARRIED OUT OTHER THAN WITHIN THE DESIGNATED REFUELLING AREA.

The refuelling area will be located at the far end of the service area and you are encouraged to take your car there within your service period after allowing major components to cool down following completion of a special stage, but in sufficient time so as not to have to rush to get to the next stage arrival control.

Due to Covid restrictions, a physical driver's briefings will not be held. A copy of the briefing will be e-mailed to all competitors prior to the event, and both crew members must familiarise themselves with its content prior to the event.

Please ensure that you are familiar with the current Covid regulations and recommendations for Wales issued by the Welsh Assembly Government. Your co-operation in minimising close contact etc is requested to keep us all safe and to reduce the risk of further restrictions and lockdowns being reintroduced within motorsport events. All personnel attending the venue are advised to ensure that a negative Lateral Flow Test is taken before departing for the venue.

Please also remember that **dogs are not permitted within the venue (even if they are in vehicles!!)**. Anyone with dogs will be asked to leave by the circuit management – and this policy is strictly enforced by them.
